The fully fitted kitchens with fine European stainless steel appliances are a chef's paradise: fridge with freezer & ice maker, gas stove, oven, Nespresso machine, coffee maker, microwave, kettle, blender and dishwasher along with all crockery & cooking utensils, cooking island and breakfast bar or dining table.


French sliding doors open onto spacious hardwood decks with covered dining area, loungers, sun beds and private massaging hot tubs to relax and enjoy the view.
