Set up in a botanical garden on a hill overlooking the lake, it is dedicated to the life of Saint Francis. It has 21 chapels built between the 15th and the 17th centuries, richly decorated with frescoes and terracotta statues by famous artists. This astonishing site is a real jewel.

Wander around the picturesque town of Orta San Giulio. The town is a maze of fascinating little streets filled with restaurants, wine bars, art galleries, gourmet and local craft shops. Guests will enjoy magnificent sunsets from there, especially from the main square overlooking San Giulio island where visitors can go to by boat until late in the evening.

Vacciago, where Palazzo Novara is located, lies just above the picturesque town of Orta San Giulio and overlooks the lake and San Giulio island. It is an untouched baroque village full of fascinating 16th and 17th century buildings. It has been a holiday destination for noble families from Milan and Piedmont ever since.

Art lovers will find the Calderara Foundation an impressive place where several modern art pieces have been collected by the Calderara family over the years.

All services and amenities are within easy reach of Palazzo Novara. The Palazzo is in close proximity to golf courses, horseback-riding facilities, cycle paths and water sports. The area is renowned for its choice of restaurants, from rustic trattorias to high end culinary establishments to delight even the most refined of palates. Guests will find themselves in a region with one the richest culinary traditions in Italy, home of truffles and prestigious wines.

Surrounded by an authentic flower explosion everywhere in spring and early summer and the magical colours of the trees in autumn, the scenery is breathtaking.
