Overview

Villa Del Olmo is a sleek contemporary house in the Pollença region, on Mallorca's quieter side.

Interior & Grounds

One of the villa's most stunning features is undoubtedly its unusual architecture. The house is on ground level, and spread out in a horseshoe shape around the elegant gardens and pool. The 13m x 5m pool is complete with Roman steps leading into it, and plenty of tiled space for sunloungers. It is situated within the villa's lush lawn gardens, which surround the house and are peppered with trees.

A parking area leads up to the main entrance of the house, which in turn leads to the villa's spacious modern lounge. From the lounge there are doors out to a covered terrace, perfect for a late-morning breakfast or cocktails during the hottest hours of the day. The terrace itself is the length of the whole villa, and looks out over the garden. From the lounge guests can also access a bathroom and a fully-equipped kitchen, the latter of which also leads out onto the large terrace. The kitchen also leads to a dining room which has its own BBQ kitchen and doors to the terrace, making both inside and outside dining possible.

From the other side of the lounge, you can find the bedrooms. The double bedroom boasts its own en suite bathroom and private door to the terrace. There are two twin rooms with en suite shower rooms, and lastly a further additional twin room.






Location & Local Information
