Villa Poggio Region: Tuscany Sleeps: 18

Overview

Villa Poggio is set on an olive-covered hill in the heart of the Chiana Valley near Marciano della Chiana. It is an ancient medieval town of historical significance, known for the site of the Battle of Scannagallo.

The villa has stunning panoramic views over the valley, with Cortona, Castiglion Fiorentino and the Montecchio Castle in the distance.

The elegant old villa still shows signs of its past splendour in the frescoes discovered during the recent restoration. There is also a small cottage located next to the main building.

The villa is surrounded by a two hectare garden with meadows, olive trees and a natural wood of ash, oaks and old cypresses. A large swimming pool completes the scene.

Ideal for rest and relaxation, the villa is also strategically positioned to reach the most important artistic cities of central Italy: Rome, Florence, Cortona, Arezzo, Perugia, Assisi, Siena, Montalcino, and Pienza.

The Main House

Ground floor

The ground floor offers a large kitchen with dishwasher, microwave, oven, washing machine and kitchen utensils. There is a charming, dining room and lounge with large fireplace, satellite TV and internet. Guests can relax in the comfortable and stylish surroundings and enjoy the stunning views. There are two double bedrooms and one twin bedroom, each with its own en suite bathroom. One of which is perfect for the elderly or disabled with easy access, and a large bathroom.

Lucignano is an ancient village in southern Tuscany located at the top of a gentle hill in Val di Chiana. It borders the provinces of Arezzo and Siena, and it represents one of the most extraordinary examples of a medieval town with its concentric elliptical ring roads.


Guests who walk in its maze of streets will have a sense of pleasant fun. Every corner is worth a visit and a photo. The upper part of the town includes the Town Hall, with its museum full of precious objects, the Church of S. Francesco, filled with frescoes by Bartolo di Fredi, the Collegiate Church and the Church of the Society of Mercy, with its unique museum.

Lucignano is a favourable location in a dominant position at 414 meters above sea level, in the Val di Chiana on the road between Siena and Arezzo. It is an area of historical importance since ancient times. Today, the central location and proximity to major roads and railways makes the town extremely interesting as a starting point for visiting the most important historical and artistic sites in central Italy.

The town has the charm of an ancient village that has preserved the traditional agricultural and craft and offers the visitors an exciting range of products: high-quality extra virgin olive oil, honey wine and Chianina meat. The region is also famed for its furniture, carvings, ceramics and jewelry.
